

ANDREWSFIELD 50MT SHOOTING RANGE

The range warden is: Peter Pullenger 07412 357413

Any Club using the Range must hold full insurance indemnity for all its members with a minimum of £10,000,000 public cover.

Any Club using the range shall be under the control of a Designated Range Officer during the time that the Club is using the range.

He will be responsible for all matters of range safety, discipline and procedure during his Clubs tenure of the range. He will not accept control of the Range unless he considers it is in a safe and suitable condition.

He will not allow any shooting to commence or continue unless he considers the range is in a suitable and safe condition.

He will be solely responsible for range safety, conduct and procedure.

A First Aider shall be nominated and in attendance.

Only pistol caliber and black powder type guns may be used. Shotguns discharging shot fall outside these categories.

Rifles discharging long natured rounds may negate the range safety envelope due to a higher chance of ricochet and will not be used.

Shooting shall only be at suitable targets. No ricochet inducing materials may be introduced anywhere that they could be struck by a round.

No targets are to be placed on, or attached to the sand retaining wooden sleepers or target holder sleepers. The median centerline for all targets is 1.5 metres from ground level. Only wooden holders should be used to hold targets. Only biodegradable paper targets will be used. Wooden posts are not targets. No targets are to be placed outside the central area of the sand bullet catcher.

No more than one person to shoot per lane. All shooting must be in echelon to target.

Please return the sand backstop to a slope of 34 degrees.

The range shall be left in a clean and tidy condition and the range book signed off by the Range Officer, noting his and the clubs name, and the times that the range was under his control.

Any damage to the range may be charged to the Club.

Any Club or individual flouting these rules will be banned from the range.
