

RODING RIFLE & PISTOL CLUB

Dear Member,

Following the publication of the updated guidance from the NSRA and NRA, We have proposed to open the club, starting in limited sessions.

Roding Rifle and Pistol Club is obliged to follow a process of adhering to the UK Government, NSRA and NRA guidelines in order to re-open. We have to ensure compliance before a definite date can be set; however we are doing everything possible to have everything in place during the week beginning Saturday 29th of August 2020.

At the moment it is proposed to open the club for two days a week, Wednesdays 12.00 -16.00 & Saturdays 10.00-16.00 initially, this will ensure that the procedures we have put in place are correct and workable. We are hopeful that more opening days will be added in due course. It must be appreciated however, that there is a lot of responsibility and not an insignificant risk to the RCO on duty, who has to attend during opening times; this means the designated key holders have to give their consent to attend the club on the nominated day(s). It is important to remember that the club has a duty of care to volunteers and club members. The club must ensure that the health and safety of volunteers and club members is protected and maintained at all times.

In accordance with the above, the following procedures are to be adhered to at all times when attending the club:

If any member, or someone in their household, has Covid-19 symptoms they should stay at home and must not attend the club under any circumstances. This includes anyone who has been out of the country to any of the named countries listed on the UK Government web site or told to self-isolate under the NHS Test and Trace service. They should inform the Club Secretary if they develop symptoms so that other members can be informed about possible contact.

RRPC IS ONLY OPEN TO FULLY PAID UP MEMBERS

1. All attendance is by appointment only. You will need to call, 07538 251730 to book a session, this can only be done on the designated day(s) and time's that the club opens, as that is where the phone and the login book will be kept. You will be given a 60 minute time slot & allocated a firing point.
2. Please do not enter the premises until you are called in by the RCO. You will not be allowed in before your (booked) allocated time.
3. Face masks must be worn on entry to the club and whilst on the RRPC premises. Disposable gloves to be worn in the club at all times, you must take them with you and dispose of them, once you leave the premises. Please do dispose of used gloves the bin situated in the car park. They must be taken with you for disposal. You must use the hand sanitiser provided on entry to the club, leaving the club and frequently during your time in the range.
4. All attendees must sign the Covid-19 waiver form before entering the range. In signing the form you give your consent to be contacted by the NHS or any such agency if it is deemed necessary.
5. The 60 mins time slot is to include 15 minutes for each member to sanitise the firing point, also at the end of their allotted session ready, in preparation for the next member to shoot; all cleaning materials will be provided BY RRPC free of charge.
6. No RRPC member's guests or children are allowed on the premises, unless they are a verified member on a parent's membership and can shoot safely on their own.
7. Targets will be provided on entry to the range, please only take one at a time.
8. All waste accumulated when you are on the range, including, but not limited to, cartridge cases, boxes & targets are to be taken away with you when you leave to dispose of at your discretion.
9. No club guns, ear defenders and spotting scoops will be available you must use your own. Also do not share your gun or equipment with anyone else in attendance.
10. No food or drink to be consumed on the premises at any time. And no seating will be available at times that the club is open
11. The toilet facilities will not be available; however, the sink in the "kitchen" area will be available to wash your hands etc. sanitising hand wash will be placed next to the sink.

The procedures detailed above are subject to change at any time. Other procedures and conditions of use may be reviewed / updated to ensure guidelines are being met. Please be patient, we are feeling our way along this path and hopefully things will go smoothly. We were given the update on how to open on the 16th July and we have been working towards an opening strategy, since this date. That can now be confirmed as the 29th Aug 2020

If you need .22 ammunition from the club PLEASE bring the correct amount £5-00 for 50 rounds as no change will be given as that would increase the risk to the RCO on duty.
